



Type A102JL1 Handicap Plate Graphic Part Identification Instructions



- 1. Markings "per order."
- 2. Braille and symbols according to 1992 ANSI A117.1.4.10 and A117.1.4.28 and must satisfy the latest ADA/ grade 11 Braille requirements.
- 3. Material and Finish Options:

ADAAG contrast compliant: white paint = WHT; black paint = BLK (-WHT-BLK or -BLK-WHT)

Black with brushed stainless steel finish = SS4

Black with brushed brass finish = BR7 (-BLK-SS4, -BLK-BR7, -SS4-BLK, -BR7-BLK)

Non-ADAAG compliant:

mirror stainless = SS8; mirror brass = BR8 (-BLK-SS8, -BLK-BR8, - BR8-BLK, - SS8-BLK)

4. Part identification and symbol shapes for A102JL1:

If alphanumeric: A102JL1-desired alphanumeric finish-desired background finish-desired alphanumeric

Example: For "L1" in white with black background: A102JL1-WHT-BLK-L1

For "A" in black with brushed stainless background: A102JL1-BLK-SS4-A

If main landing: A102JL1-main landing star and alphanumeric finish-background finish-IM plus up to three

alphanumeric as required

Example: For main landing star and "L1" in black with brushed brass background: A102JL1-BLK-BR7-IML1

International Graphic Designations



"IM——" for international main landing symbol.

Up to three alphanumerics can follow "IM".



"IALRM" for international alarm symbol



"ISTOP" for international stop symbol



"IDO" for international door open symbol



"IDC" for international door close symbol



"IRDO" for industry wide rear door open symbol



"IRDC" for industry wide rear door close symbol

"IUP" for up arrow symbol



"IDN" for down arrow symbol
